So that he may always be serious, yet never take himself too seriously.
Give him humility, so that he may always remember the simplicity of greatness,

“I (We) have not lived in vain.”*

懇求塑造我的兒子，使他有高瞻遠矚的理想，引導他認識你，同時又知道，認識自己乃是真知識的基石。主啊！我祈求你，不要讓他走在安逸、舒適的路途上，求你將他置於困難、艱苦和挑戰的磨練中，求你引領他，讓他敢於面對風浪，讓他對失敗跌倒的人滿有憐恤。

主啊！求你塑造我的兒子，求你讓他有一顆純潔的心，並有遠大的目標；讓我的兒子先懂得駕馭自己才去領導他人；懂得歡笑，但不忘如何哭泣；記取過去的教訓，又能擁抱未來。

主啊！祈求你成就他有了這些美德後，又求你賜給他充分的幽默感，以免他過於嚴肅，還苛求自己。求你賜給他謙卑的心，使他永遠記得，真正的偉大是單純，真正的智慧是坦率，真正的力量是溫和。然後作為父親的我（作為校監、校長、老師的我們），才敢低聲的說：「我(我們)沒有枉度此生了。」

我們的同學敢於釋放潛能，勇於接受挑戰，實在令我感到自豪。在藝術發展方面，我們希望透過藝術教育，帶出正面人生、發掘潛能、欣賞生命的價值。在學校的大力推動下，同學都熱情投入不同的藝術活動，如拉丁舞、中西方舞蹈、戲劇表演、武術、音樂欣賞、樂器演奏及馬賽克壁畫製作等，因此本校有幸榮獲香港藝術發展局頒發的藝術教育獎 --- 優異學校榮譽。在體育發展方面，本校同學在各項運動比賽中確有很大的進步。此外，為了給學生一個健康、關愛及愉快的學習環境，老師都竭盡所能照顧同學各方面的需要。為了擴闊同學的視野，老師又為同學安排了不同的參觀和工作坊，讓同學在求學之餘，又可接觸書本以外的知識，引發他們對社會的關注，為他們成為世界公民做好準備，為此本年度本校榮獲「關愛校園」獎。在學校大力推動學生發展多元智能的情況下，同學在不同範疇優異的表現均獲得肯定，如南華早報年度傑出運動員獎、由國泰航空主辦的「我要高飛」學生大使、在「4·23 世界閱讀日 2014」創作比賽-----「地球與我」的高中組中榮獲佳績、擔任聯合國兒童基金會大使、香港屈臣氏學生運動員獎等。

我們今天所獲得的成就，就是未來繼續發展全方位及全人教育的基石。在此要衷心感謝學校捐建人吳汪靜宜女士、施主席、陳校監、學校法團校董會及辦學團體(東華三院)無私支持學校的發展。我們現正進行硬件設施的提升，來年將會全校鋪設無線網絡，購買更多平板電腦以助提升同學學習英語的興趣、推行專題研習、電子學習及自主學習。在學業方面，我們會整合閱讀課程，透過有趣的跨學科閱讀，以助同學掌握更多英語詞彙。現在的學習已經不一定在教室裡面發生，而且更要注意學習的持續性及多元化，因此我們正積極建立全面的生涯規劃教育及工作實習計劃，以擴大同學的學習範圍。

為了讓學生有更優質的學習環境，學校又將設計一個優秀學生蒼萃廊，展示學生努力的成果；建造一條自然教育徑，裡面會有魚池、水力發電等裝置，以提高同學的綠色環保意識；並增設藝術創作教室，發展同學的藝術潛能；又會鼓勵同學報讀外語課程，參與資歷認證考試，增強語文能力。

以上所做的一切，正如施校監在去年結業典禮說，都是為了提升同學的競爭力、培養同學的自信、自尊、幫助同學尋找自己心中的北極星。我們各個持份者，都會盡心盡力朝着學校的願景及使命奮鬥。
